Syria crisis appeal

As the violence spreads in Syria, frightened, desperate and exhausted refugees are pouring across the border into Jordan and Lebanon. Over 1 million refugees have fled the country so far, and around 7,000 more leave the country every day. The situation continues to worsen and the refugee camps have made an international call for assistance.

Families arrive in overcrowded camps with little more than the clothes they are wearing and what they can carry in small backpacks. Nearly 80 per cent of refugees are women and children, making them hugely vulnerable.

We are concentrating on women and young people who are the most vulnerable in this emergency situation.

£90 could provide one vulnerable family living outside a refugee camp everything they need for one month

£200 could train a psychosocial volunteer to support people to overcome the emotional impact of the conflict
